Player registration will begin at 12:40 a.m. for the 100-player field. First tee time begins at 1:40 AM. Lunch and beverage will be provided. Upon completion, the prize committee will present the awards to the winners and losers. During this time, everyone can enjoy food, wine, soda, and an opportunity to mingle with friends and strangers!

This is a 2 Player (man or woman) scramble tournament and will be played under the scramble rules (see below).

SCRAMBLE RULES

- ✚ **Each group competes as a team for the LOWEST TEAM SCORE for the 18 holes.**
- ✚ **2 Player Team will be paired up with another 2 Player Team based on an average handicap**

METHOD OF PLAY

1. Play begins with each member of the group teeing off.
2. With the agreement of the other member of the group, the team decides which drive is the most desirable.
3. The other members of the group pick up their ball and proceed to the spot of the selected drive, where they will hit their second shots.
4. The best of the second shots is then chosen. The group will then hit all their putts (or third shots) from that spot.
5. This procedure continues until the ball is in the hole.
6. At the end of each hole, the score for the group is recorded on the card.

OTHER RULES

1. Place balls within one club length of the original ball
2. In placing the ball, you may not change the condition of the shot. If the ball is in a hazard or rough, all members of the team must play their shot from the hazard or rough, respectively.
3. On the putting green, give each person a shot at the first putt. **Do not hole out a short putt if you have missed your first putt.** The first ball in must count. Mark your ball and wait.
4. If playing as a threesome, one member of the threesome may on a rotational basis, hit or putt an extra time to compensate for the fourth person.
5. Purchased Muligans can be used by one player only. If another player purchased their own Muligan, he/she can then use that mulligan if one wishes to do so. A maximum of 4 muligans can be used in the front 9, and a maximum of 4 on the back 9.
